between 8:30 and 9 a.m. Judging will begin at 9:30 a.m. A printed copy of the recipe for publication is to be submitted at the time of check-in.

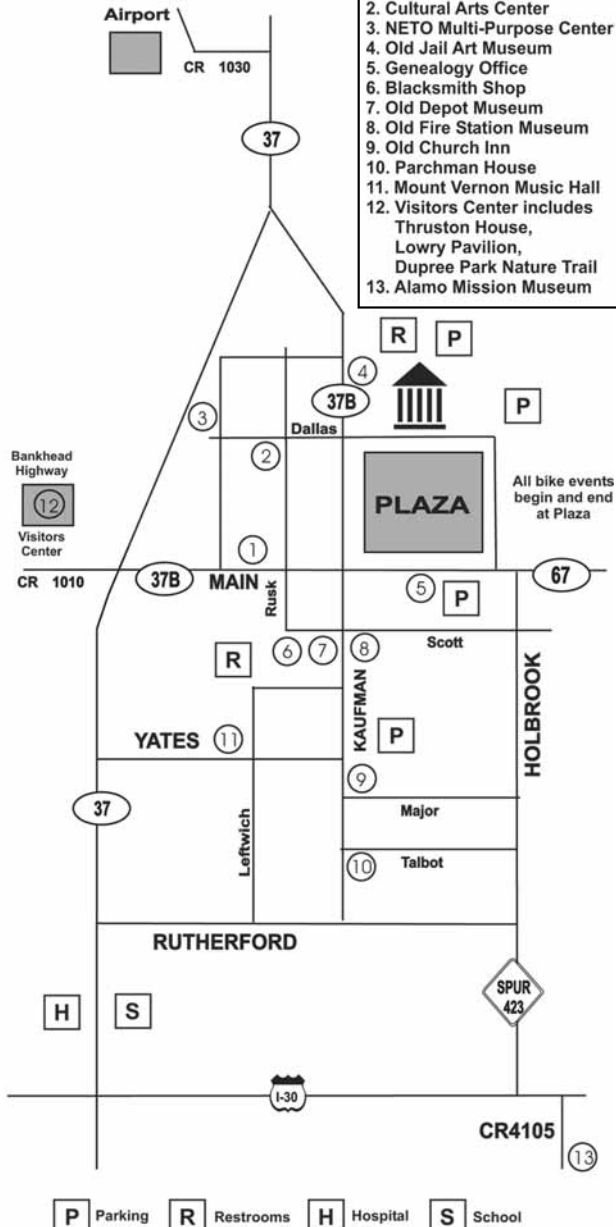
